



Thank you for deciding to take your course at the University of Huddersfield and for selecting residential accommodation.

The university offers 2 different types of accommodation, which are privately owned and situated short bus rides away from campus. Below is an outline of each type of accommodation available.

Storthes Hall En-suite -
single - £82.95 per week,
double for single occupancy - £99.95 per week,
twin room - £66.95 per week.

Storthes Hall Student Village is situated in 336 acres of parkland to the south of campus, and has almost 1500 generously sized bedrooms. A free shuttle bus service is provided for all residents, to and from the university, during term times only, which takes approximately 20-25 minutes. All rooms are en-suite, with broadband access. There are well equipped kitchen and dining areas shared between 6 and 8 students. Storthes Hall boasts a variety of sporting, social and study facilities.

Ashenhurst Standard -
Single - £65.95 per week,
single deluxe - £75.95 per week.

Ashenhurst sits in pleasant woodlands close to the university, and has 280 student rooms. The residences are less than 1.5 miles from campus and regular transport is provided by the local bus service. The bus ride takes approximately 10-15 minutes. All bedrooms have a washbasin and broadband access. There are well equipped communal kitchens, lounges, dining areas and bathrooms. There is also a leisure area with TV and DVD facilities, games consoles and vending machines for use by all Ashenhurst students.
